The training is aimed at key public service providers, local development and community groups including residents associations. It will help people to take a leadership role in their organisation in developing awareness of issues relating to racism and sectarianism. By doing the course, people will learn how to actively promote equality and inclusivity for all citizens of County Cavan.

The training is initially for one day with an option to continue further training and support in the autumn.

During the course the participants will focus on the following:

- What diversity means: challenges and benefits
- Exploration of personal attitudes, values, beliefs and prejudices and their origin
- Develop understanding of the historical and contemporary context of racism and sectarianism
- Reflection on the role of leadership in challenging times
- Develop ways of translating new knowledge into practice in terms of leadership.
- Develop understanding of the minority / majority power dynamics
